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POST SCLEROTHERAPY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. You may remove the cotton balls and tape 6 hours after the completion of your procedure; you must then reapply your hose. Do not shower or bathe at this time.
- 2. You may not remove your hose for **24** hours or until the evening after your procedure (at which time you may shower). Please reapply the following morning and wear for the next **3-4** weeks (per the Doctor's instructions), when you are on your feet the most (a minimum of 8-10 hours per day). For the longevity of your hose we recommend that you wash them by hand and hang them to dry. It is also beneficial to purchase a pair of rubber gloves to help in the application of the hose.
- 3. Do not apply Band-Aids or antibiotic ointment to the injection sites as it can cause a severe reaction with the sclero. If a small irritation does develop at the injection site please keep it clean and dry with soap, water and gauze coverings.
- 4. Bruising and lumps are a normal reaction to the injections and will disappear in time. It is not uncommon to experience a varying degree of a burning sensation or an ache for a short period of time following your procedure. Tylenol is usually sufficient to help with this discomfort.
- 5. If you develop an intense heat, drainage or severely increasing tenderness, please call the office at **314-849-0923** or **877-849-0923** to speak to a nurse.
